

What a stupendous witness to our prayer-hearing God was George Muller, who had but a shilling to start. When he died he had only 180 pounds to his credit in the bank, but in his life he received and distributed 1,500,000 pounds, yet never appealed to a man. "No less than five thousand times have I gone to bed with no provision for the morrow." "Did you sleep soundly?" "Every time." My friends, it is a most serious matter that calls for the profoundest prostration, that in all this multitude of possibilities and practical knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ, there should be so few of us who know what it is to make a splendid venture of faith on the omnipotence and omniscience of the unchangeable God.
