If Christ is not Divine, in the absolute sense of the word, then God's gift of Christ is not an expression of His love. If Christ is a mere creature, it cost Him nothing to give Him. The whole point of John 3:16, with its "God so loved..." is that God, in giving "His only begotten Son," did that which was unspeakably costly to Himself; but if His gift was a mere creature, it was not the least costly to Himself. Nay, worse; for other than not being an expression of love, it is an act of strange cruelty that God should delegate one of his un-fallen innocent creatures to the bitter ordeal of that awful Cross and the agony which are now forever identified with human sin. The lustre dies off John 3:16 and its kindred texts. They become pathetically meaningless. "God so loved the world that He gave-an angel, a seraph, a creature of high rank." What does any such gift as these convey of divine love? Nothing? The glory of the gospel lies in the fathomless mystery that for our sakes God gave up, to the shame and suffering of Calvary, One who was eternally the Son of His bosom and the delight of His heart.
