“So it was that for a whole year they assembled with the church and taught a great many people. And the disciples were first called Christians at Antioch” (Acts 11:26). Those who have most powerfully impacted the world for Christ were people of vision. Spiritual vision and commitment are strands of a cord used to raise high the banner of the cross. These people of God laboring at Antioch were people of vision and were people of tireless zeal and unflagging commitment.
