But find a way to defeat the temptation to serve only when it's convenient or exciting. That's not disciplined service. Those with a servant's heart and eyes will find themselves compelled by love to serve in ways and times beyond the bounds of their "official" ministry. People with unusual schedules or physical limitations, if they have the heart to serve, will do so despite their limitations. They will not neglect the ongoing ministry of the local Body of Christ. -Whitney
