The great central figure of Scripture must be the object of your affections or you will read Scripture with little profit. The great defect of modern Christianity is that there is so little love for Christ. Many hear what is called the "clear gospel," and trusting in the blood and work of Christ they get the assurance of the Word of God that they will never perish, and this seems to satisfy them and they settle down upon it and go to sleep. There is not the earnest longing after Himself; watching daily at His gates. Did it ever occur to you that Christ values your affections? You belong to Him; you are the object of His love; you are "His own." Your heart is Christ's property: is it his dwelling place. —Coates
